



Safe Driving Steering Committee

The Safe Driving Steering Committee (SDSC) is a local prevention group that aims to prevent distracted and impaired driving and provide road safety education to the Eagle County community. The SDSC is composed of various community stakeholders: Law Enforcement, Medical Providers, Attorneys, Transportation providers, Driving Schools, Local Governments, Nonprofits and Businesses.

Steering Committee Priorities:

1. Create road safety events
2. Increase education and awareness of driving laws
3. Increase awareness of high risk driving behaviors, including distracted and impaired driving
4. Facilitate a Driver's Education Scholarship program
5. Engage youth voice
6. Conduct an annual environmental scan

Meeting Schedule:

The SDSC averages one meeting a month that is 1.5 hours long. This meeting is in-person with a virtual option. There may be additional meetings scheduled, as needed, for event planning or youth feedback.
